#### **Notes From the Food & Clothing Shelf**

We continue to stock used Bibles on the shelves of our food room. We are excited to report that we have had a huge uptick in guests taking the Bibles. One lady said she got one and reads at least a chapter a day. Please know that we are feeding the body and the soul.

We also have seen numerous immigrants come to the food shelf who, we found out, had just arrived in the US days before visiting our Food & Clothing Shelf. They feel so blessed that they have food and clothing to start out their new life in Minnesota.

Along with the many blood pressure screenings done during the month we also occasionally have other at-risk situations arise. On September 20, a very busy Wednesday evening, we had two individuals with major health needs in which staff dealt with amazing care. Most days we have retired nurse volunteers as we did this evening. One homeless individual came looking for a shirt and pants to cover a severe infection of Poison Oak Ivy. (i.e., the biblical reference of the leper). After receiving the clothes, the individual was encouraged to go to the ER immediately. A ride to ER was offered but was declined. The other guest was bent over with severe spinal back pain. We helped to gather the food and placed the bags in the car.

We pray for all these people and everyone that comes to our door for any help we can offer. Thanks to the congregation for sponsoring this Food & Clothing ministry.
