#### SPDR Spring Trip

On December 10, 2021, western Kentucky was struck by several tornadoes, affecting many communities. One of the tornadoes was on the ground for over 165 miles. Overall, the 190 mph winds killed 57 people and injured over 500. In Mayfield alone, more than 4,000 structures were damaged or destroyed. A 22-member team will be leaving for Mayfield, KY this Saturday, April 20 to work on constructing new homes and replacing homes destroyed by the tornado.
