1. SPDR – Katie

September trip to Clarksville, TN - The SPDR fall trip started September 21 as 13 team members left from St. Philip's. Joining them in Clarksville, TN were seven additional team members. Team members come from five different states. This is the first SPDR trip to Clarksville following a large tornado in December 2023 that damaged or destroyed 700 homes and businesses in Clarksville, a town of 180,000.

The team's rebuilding work is under the supervision of the Tennessee Western Kentucky United Methodist Church. The team will be working on home repairs including painting, sheet rocking and window installation.

We're down about \$20K for the year, but we're paid ahead on benevolence and honorariums and we have money in accumulated reserve so we are still doing ok.

BFTF-II: There's about \$11K in dedicated accounts so we'll still need about \$100K or so more to complete the remaining projects. The plan had been to switch around the order of priority and start the fellowship

hall remodel this fall/winter since the parking lot project can't be done until spring/summer. However, since there's not enough money in the fund yet we'll consider delaying that project to give time to raise the needed funds.

Jordan Young, who does our snow plowing, emailed with concerns about the location of the gaga ball pit. It's currently located in an area that is used to pile snow when plowing the parking lot. He's concerned about possible damage to the pit and suggested moving the pit somewhere else so it doesn't get damaged.

We went outside to assess possible places to relocate the gaga ball pit. We'd ideally like to keep it close to where it currently sits so it's accessible and people are still able to use it. A suggested new location was agreed upon by the Board and a stake placed where we'd like to move it so Jordan can see and make sure that will work for him.
