- We're 1/3 of the way through the year and in pretty good shape. YTD is about -\$6553 but we were up \$10,000 for April. No need to panic yet.
- We invested \$100K into a 13-month CD at 4% earlier this year. That will come due in February.
- Propose doing a laddered CD, so we'd invest another \$100K or \$80K so every 6 months we'd have interest income from a CD coming due with about \$4000 in income each time from a \$100K CD.
 - If we needed the money before the CD was due we could withdraw the money but just wouldn't get the interest income.
 - o Further discussion about this and a vote at the June meeting.

Business Manager's Report

- Spring Cleanup May 17 was a success
 - Did leaf blowing, flower gardens taken care of, mulching by the garden group, tennis court area cleaned up
 - o Amazing Grace members and Scouts showed up to help.
- SPDR Trip to Clarksville, TN The group split up to work in 2 locations. One had flood damage and the other had tornado damage.
 - Flood damaged home Worked on sheet rocking. Some of the sheet rock that had been delivered was rained on so they couldn't use it. Also moved electrical up.
 - Tornado damaged home Painted all rooms, put in new subflooring, new laminate flooring, deck railing, re-sided the garage & reattached a door. The storm had pulled a wall out, so the team built a structure to hold the wall in place.

- o The team ran out of siding so went to work on a third home. The home had shifted off of its foundation and had moved back. The team took down some crown molding and put up other molding. The last work needed on that house is now finished.
- Last week we turned on AC. The unit in Connie's office isn't working as well as another one in the office. Katie will talk to Property & Grounds about options.
- Turned on heat today.
- Lights for Sanctuary have been ordered.
- A Fellowship Hall account had been started in 2016. Motion made and approved to move all of the funds from the Fellowship Hall account (approximately \$5000) to the BFTFII account.

 - Another company works with the Mounds View district. (Specifically Mounds View High School, not Irondale right now) Our info goes to the whole school for spring sports and will be good through the whole school year.

 have a page with churches listed. It's distributed to every home in
 NE Mpls, also Columbia Heights.
