Columbarium News & Update

The Columbarium committee is excited to announce that the Columbarium has had a face lift. A crew has completed the restoration of the grounds. The Hosta plants have been separated and dead ones have been replaced. New chips have been added. The cobblestones have been cleaned and leveled. The lower-level overgrown ground cover has been removed and replaced with all new plants. The stepping stone pathway on the garage side of the Columbarium has been moved and cleaned up. And ground lights are scheduled to be added at the base of the eventual Columbarium space to be installed on the garage side of fellowship hall windows. Please feel free to visit the beautiful grounds.

To date, 81 of 93 niches have been sold since its installation in 2015. Twelve niches are still available for sale and when all are sold plans are being made to install a second Columbarium on the footings already installed on the right side of the Fellowship Hall windows
